



## Level 2 British Sign Language Course

Deaf Connexions are running a “Signature” BSL Level 2 course

Starting Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019

Monday evenings 7pm to 9pm

The course will take place at WNDA The Deaf Centre, Railway Road,  
Kings Lynn

This is a 50 week course, including assessment time and students can achieve a nationally recognised certificate at the end.

The qualification is divided into three assessed units, 201,202,203. To achieve the full Level 2 Award in British Sign Language candidates are required to pass all units.

It is suitable to anyone who has a basic level of skills and knowledge in BSL. Generally you will have achieved level 1 BSL.

Candidates are assessed by a combination of a multiple choice exam paper, a presentation, and a conversation in BSL.

At the end of the qualification, learners will be able to:

- Participate in longer and more varied conversations than at Level 1.
- Develop communication in BSL about real life, routine, and daily experiences.
- Deal with most routine communication and have enough understanding of grammar to cope with some non-routine communication.
- Have knowledge of a number of regional variations in sign language.

**The cost for course £470 including assessments** (this could be subject to a slight change)

(We require a minimum of 8 students for the course to run)
